DEFINITIONS/GLOSSARY

Volunteer Driver Program:

Services where volunteers drive eligible consumers who need door-through-door assistance for critical needs.

• Transit Tickets:

Programs that distribute free or subsidized tickets to eligible consumers for public transit and/or paratransit rides.

General Public Transit:

Buses, trains, and ferries with fixed routes and schedules that are open to the general public.

ADA Paratransit:

Curb-to-curb or door-to-door services provided by public transit operators as mandated by the American's with Disabilities Act.

Group Trip/Excursions:

Round-trip accessible van rides for pre-planned outings e.g. special events, shopping or religious services.

Taxi Subsidy:

Programs that allow eligible consumers to use taxis at a reduced fare

Door-to-Door Ride Programs:

Pre-scheduled, accessible, door-to-door services provided by cities/organizations.

• Fixed-Route Shuttle:

Accessible vans that operate on fixed routes and schedules that are provided by cities or community organizations.

• Travel Training:

Group and individual training and assistance that helps consumers learn to travel independently on public transit and other transportation services.
